



## Wedding Favor Gift Box

### **Project Description:**

Make a wedding day even more special and creative with hand-crafted wedding favor gift boxes. Transform an ordinary juice carton into an “upcycled” wedding sentiment! This quick and easy project adds elegance and style to your celebration! It’s affordable, eco-conscious and can be easily customized to your wedding theme!

### Supply List:

- Empty Juice Carton
- White VELCRO® brand Sticky Back™ Coins
- Bridal wrapping paper
- Gold Glitter
- Classic Mod Podge by Plaid
- Flat Back Acrylic Gems
- Hot Glue
- Clear Acrylic “Diamonds”
- White Faux Flowers
- Faux Pearl Beads
- White Marabou Boa

- 1/8" Satin Ribbon

Recommended Tools:

- Hobby Knife
- Westcott Titanium Bonded Non Stick Scissors
- AdTech Hot Glue Gun
- Paintbrush
- Pencil
- Marker



**Project Instructions:**

1. Decide how tall you want to make your box. (For example, the box pictured is about 2-1/2 inches tall.) Measure that many inches from the bottom of the carton, mark with a straight, horizontal line on the front and sides of the juice carton.
2. As shown in the photo, the fourth side of the carton should be made as tall as the box height plus the width that will fold over to make a lid plus enough material for a lid flap. Draw the cut lines on the carton with a marker.
3. Draw the cut lines for the side flaps.

4. Make straight cuts along the lines on front and sides of the carton.
5. Finish cutting out the box shape from the juice carton. Important: Save the excess juice carton to make the gift tag!
6. Using the paint brush, paint the outer carton surface with decoupage, following manufacturer's instructions.
7. Wrap the bridal paper around the juice carton. Allow to dry.
8. Trim the excess paper from around the carton edges.
9. Seal the finish with one or more additional coats of decoupage. Allow to dry.
10. Fold the front corner flaps downward and secure the inside of the front closure with two white VELCRO® Sticky Back Coin Fasteners.
11. Use hot glue to decorate the carton with acrylic gems, white faux flowers, beads and boa.
12. Cut a tag shape out of the excess juice carton for the gift tag. Using a punch, create a hole in the tag. Write a personalized message or to/from on the hang tag with a marker. Loop ribbon through hole and attach ribbon to box with hot glue.
