

## Project: Window Screen



This easy window screen doesn't take time at all to make, and can completely change a room from boring and drab to fashionable and interesting.



### Material

- Radiator cover — cut to size
- Paint (quantity depends on size of screen) — try a decorative
- Spray paint
- VELCRO® brand Stick On Squares or Coins

### Steps

1. Measure the window.
2. Buy a piece of MDF radiator cover and cut to size — why not take advantage of the cutting service that many retailers now offer.
3. Paint window screen in preferred color, pale colors work best, and allow to dry (refer to paint manufacturer's advice).
4. Ensure both surfaces (window frame and screen) are clean and dry.
5. Stick VELCRO® brand Stick On Squares or Coins hook side to the window frame and loop side to the corresponding screen — we recommend you test on an inconspicuous

area first to ensure the VELCRO® brand product does not damage the frame if you need to permanently remove at a later date.

6. Allow at least 10 minutes for the adhesive to bond, then simply press the screen onto the window to secure in place.
7. Screen can be removed and re-painted to update or re-fresh your look as often as required.
