Team Spirit Changeable Socks

Materials Needed

VELCRO® Sew On fasteners

Assorted Grosgrain Ribbons: 7/8", 5/8" & 1/4"

Socks

Tools Needed

Scissor—we recommend Westcott Brand Scissors and Trimmers.

Needle

Thread

Project Tips

Layer more ribbon colors by going with wider or thinner ribbons; be creative and have fun!

To add more fullness to the floweret use more ribbon, for less fullness use 3/4 yard ribbon.

For bow use two colors for a different effect.

Project Instructions

For Floweret

1. Sew a running stitch along bottom edge of 1 yard 7/8" ribbon; pull thread together tightly to form floweret; sew bottom edge securely together at gathers.
2. Cut 3/4" VELCRO® sew On; sew loop side onto back side of floweret; sew hook side onto outside edge of sock. (Repeat for other sock)

For Two-toned Flower

3. Cut 1 yard 7/8" ribbon (green) and 1 yard of 5/8" ribbon (blue). Place blue ribbon 1/16" from edge of green ribbon.
4. Sew a running stitch along bottom edge of blue ribbon, pull thread together tightly to form flower; sew bottom edge securely together at gathers.
5. Cut 3/4" VELCRO® Sew On; sew loop side onto back side of flower.

For Bow

6. Cut 11 inches of 7/8" ribbon; fold into thirds.
7. Pleat together the middle, stitch together.
8. Wrap 1" of 1/4" ribbon around middle, stitch in place.
9. Cut V shape on ends of ribbon.
10. Cut 1/2" VELCRO® Sew On; sew loop side onto back side of bow.
